



A completely remote proctored sitting will be available for GAMSAT test takers unable to attend an in-person test sitting for the Humanities, and Biological Sciences test centre component. All requests must be submitted in writing to gamsat@acer.org. Supporting documentation will need to be provided and uploaded securely via the messaging system through your ACER account.

Remote proctoring will be made available if:

- you live more than three (3) hours' drive from a physical test centre
- you live in a country where a GAMSAT test centre is not offered*

*Test takers located in a country where a GAMSAT test centre is not offered are advised to register under 'Rest of World' by no later than the close of standard registrations for the relevant test cycle. The GAMSAT office will contact you to confirm your location and advise which supporting documents are required.

Remote proctoring will not be offered if you are travelling, or if your preferred test centre location reaches capacity. You are advised to register early to avoid disappointment.

All requests should be accompanied by supporting documentation that is specific to your situation. Acceptable documentation includes a residential utility bill or similar containing your name and residential address, statutory declaration, university housing documentation. All requests will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

If you wish to apply to sit via remote proctoring, you must do so before the close of standard registrations for the relevant cycle:

- **March 2024:** Monday 22 January 2024 9pm AEDT/10am GMT
- **September 2024:** Thursday 4 July 2024 10pm AEST/1pm BST

Please note: Requests submitted after this date will not be considered. Supporting documentation written in a language other than English must also be accompanied by a certified English translation.

Prior to your application for remote proctoring, it is important that you ensure you meet the technical and practical requirements. It is your responsibility as the test taker wishing to sit GAMSAT by remote proctoring, to ensure that you have the time, facilities, and equipment to do so successfully.

This includes:

- A desktop computer or laptop (*iPads, tablets or mobile phones are not suitable*).
- A stable internet connection.
- A functioning microphone and webcam (*some web cameras have microphones built-in*).
- A compatible browser: *Google Chrome (preferred) or Mozilla Firefox*.
- Availability to sit any/multiple days within the test window.

Whilst a desktop device with a webcam will usually be a superior option to a laptop, you are able to sit the test using a laptop. We would recommend you use an external mouse as track pads will be difficult in test conditions. If you use a laptop, for best results it is recommended it be a 15" screen or larger. However, a 13" screen will be acceptable, it will simply mean that you will have to scroll more to see the information in the questions. Please ensure that your screen resolution is set to a minimum of 1280 x 1024.

Please review the list of requirements below for your camera, operating system, upload/download speeds, RAM, ports, microphones, and browsers.
